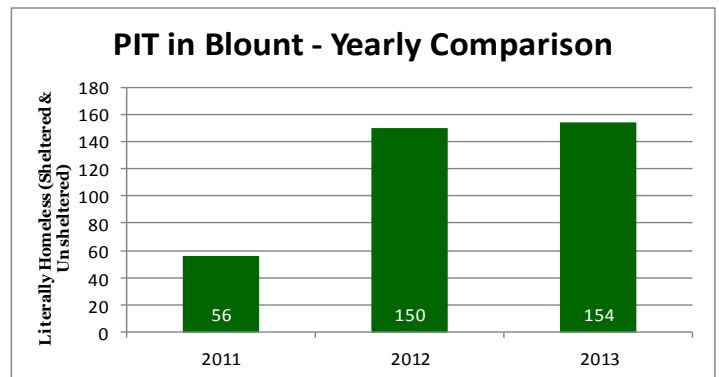
Point in Time Count 2013 - Blount County

During the Point in Time Count of People Experiencing Homelessness on January 24, 2013,

154 people were homeless (sheltered and unsheltered) and 218 people were precariously housed (almost homeless) in Blount County.

A point-in-time count is an unduplicated count on a single night of the people in a specific county who are experiencing homelessness. It includes both sheltered and unsheltered populations. This count is mandated by the Department of Housing and Urban Development and is coordinated by County mayors in conjunction with Tennessee Valley Coalition to End Homelessness.

Shelt-ES: literally homeless in shelter
 Shelt-TH: literally homeless in transitional housing
 Unshelt: literally homeless; living in place not meant for human habitation
 Prec. Hsd: Precariously Housed—almost homeless; living w/others

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964: "No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subject to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance."
