

This count is mandated by the Department of Housing and Urban Development and is coordinated by County mayors in conjunction with Tennessee Valley Coalition to End Homelessness.

Bridging the Gaps for the Tennessee Valley Region

During the Point in Time Count of People Experiencing
Homelessness on March, 10, 2014,
56 people were homeless
(sheltered and unsheltered) and
129 people were precariously housed (almost homeless)
in Blount County.
