Dear Governing Council and grantees,

On Friday morning, the Systems Performance Committee met to review the applications for the Coc Grant. Clyde Vincent could not join us, so I invited Mary Lou Hammer to sit in on the meeting in his stead. Jackie Mayo was also not available.

The attendees were Matt Winder, Chris Osborn and Mary Lou Hammer. Tammy Lynn attended to provide support.

We reviewed six applications:

Operation Restore- Renewal

Family Services- Renewal

HMIS Systems- Renewal

HMIS Renewal- Renewal

CEASE- reallocation

CoC Planning Grant- new project through set-aside funding.

The four renewal applications were ranked based on the scoring criteria sheet developed by the committee and approved by the CoC. Chris Osborn recused himself from the scoring of the Family Services grant based on a potential conflict of interest (one of the project staff is on the KHP board of directors)

The committee chose to rank the two new applications last, with the understanding that it is challenging to compare the results of the renewal applications with the projections of the new applications.

Please note that HUD has its own priorities that will supersede our rankings, so the ranking does not necessarily equate to which projects will be funded.

With all that said, the ranking of the projects were as follows.

- 1.) HMIS System
- 2.) HMIS Renewal
- 3.) Family Services
- 4.) Operation Restore
- 5.) CEASE
- 6.) CoC Planning Grant

A letter will be going out to each project agency to formally announce the rankings and provide feedback on the criteria.
