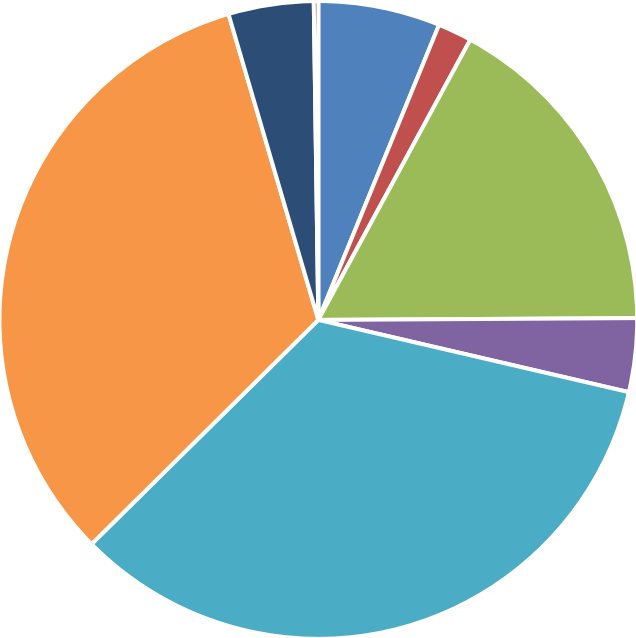

Entry & Exits by Organization

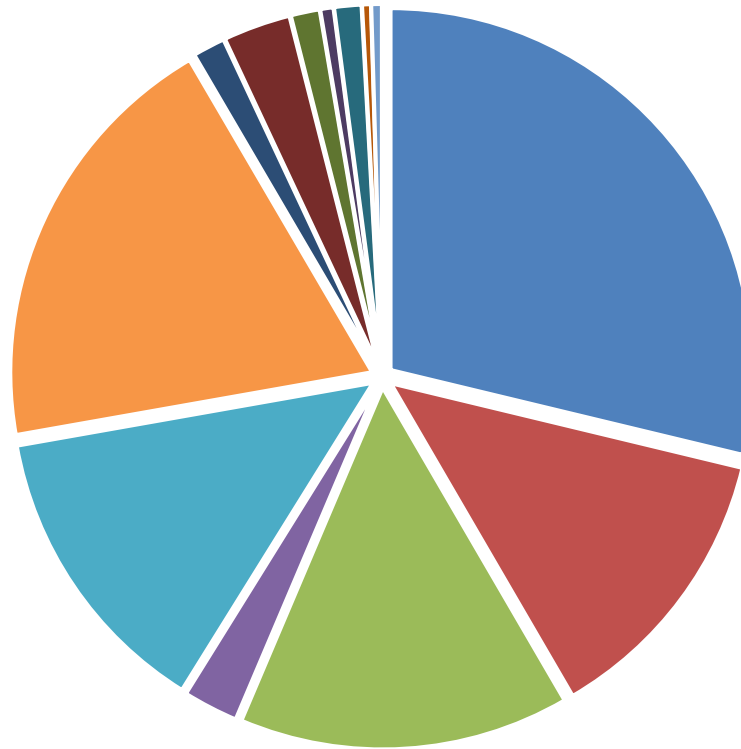

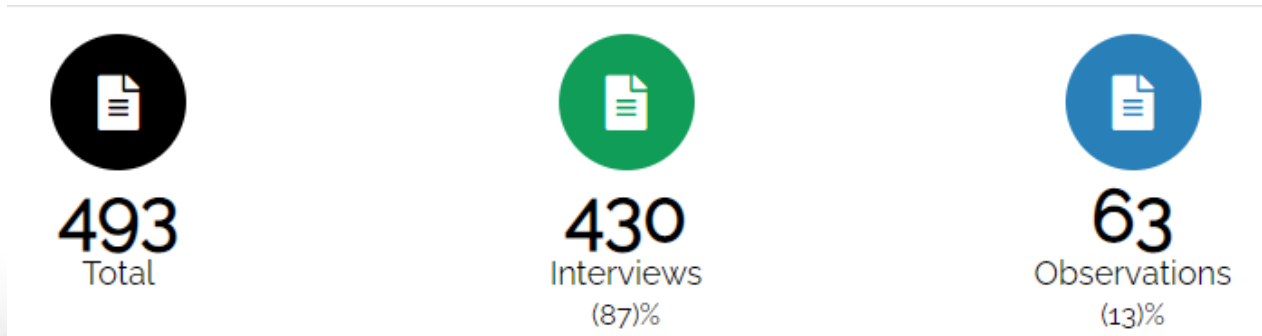

Call to Order: – Tonya Polidoro COC Chair called the meeting to order at 10:03

New Business:

Tonya Polidoro welcomed the agencies to the meeting.

Foothills Community does permanent housing. Most of their clients are in Blount Co at this time but they want to expand to Loudon, Sevier and Monroe. They also offer rental programs.

COC Data Reports:

Nikki Lynn presented some reports to the COC on various components related to ServicePoint and entering HMIS. 2 Reports Showed Entry/Exit numbers for 2022. The other was the Data Quality completeness report the COC current score is a C. Relationship to Head of Household is an F. Lynn asked that we make sure we are entering that in. Polidoro spoke up and said there have been glitches in the system and when they add new components to ServicePoint the old data will score badly. Purkey spoke up and said the HOH is a glitch that MATS has dealt with for a while now. Lynn is working with well sky trying to remedy and issues. If you are having issues like these please let her know so she can get it taken care of. January's report is looking better the COC is at a B.

Lynn gave a heads up that in October she looks for HUD to change some data elements in relation to Gender.

Lynn is going through the mail chimp account and cleaning it up. If you need to be added or have someone that needs to be added or removed please contact her.

PIT 2023:

Lynn thanked all those on the ground doing the count. It couldn't be done without the agencies doing the work. She hopes to have the final numbers out next month. Please use the counting us app to enter data it makes it easier and faster to get data. She also hopes to have a breakdown of how many each county counted.
