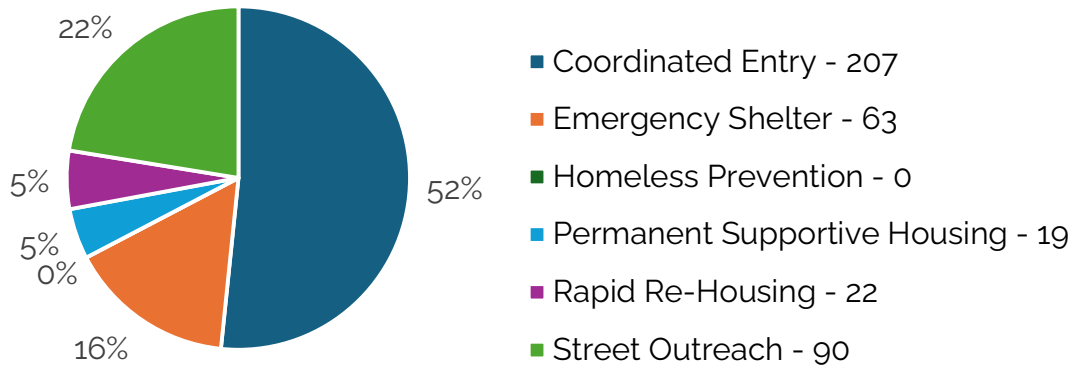


**Total Unduplicated Number of Individuals Enrolled in Programs - 263**

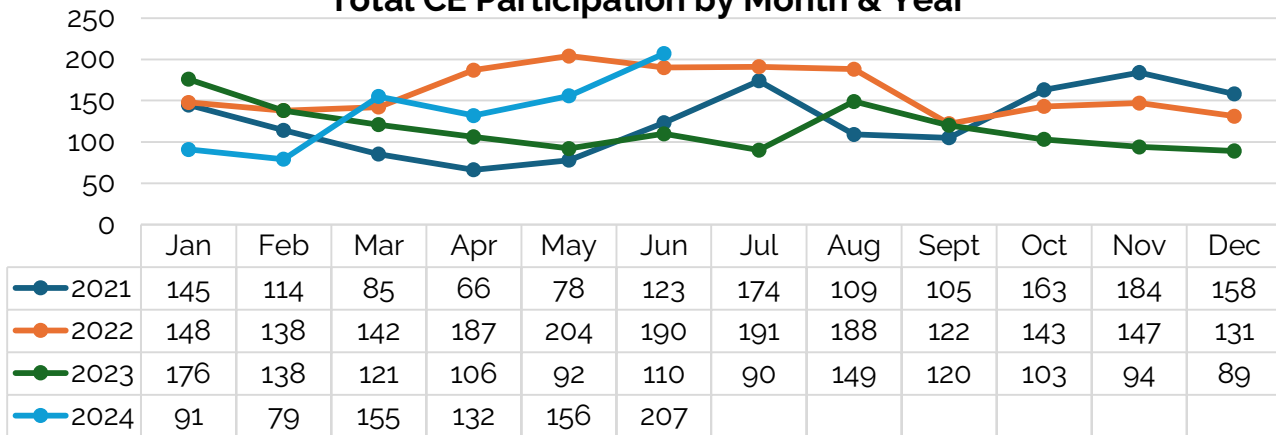

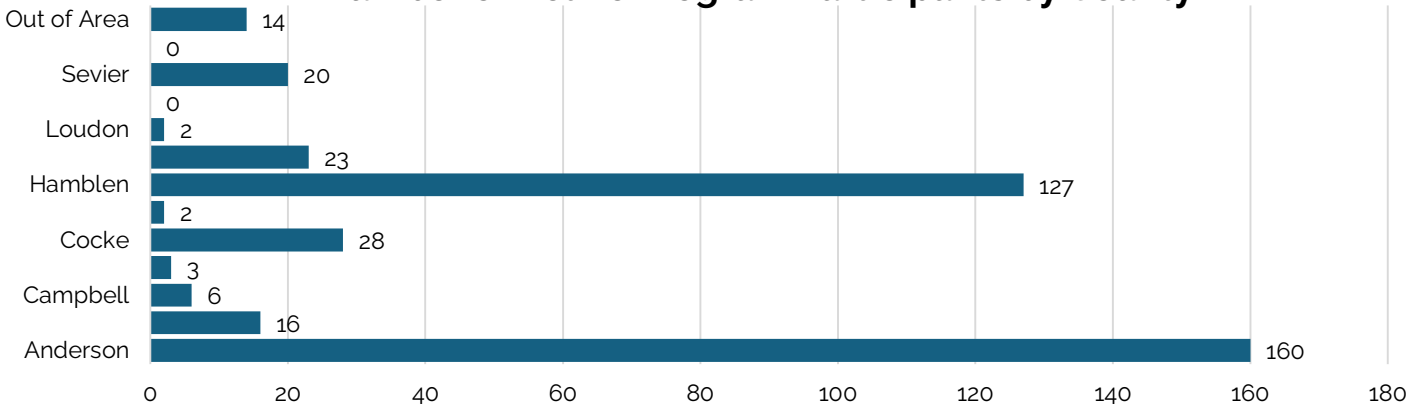
**Percentage of Total Active Entrolments by Program Type**
