







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




- Over 35 organizations and agencies assisted during the count.
- A physical census type count was conducted in all 12 counties that make up TVCoC.
- For the first time, the TVCoC PIT committee partnered with the Knoxville-Knox County CoC Outreach & Engagement Commitee to plan a true region-wide Count.
