

We repsect bodily autonomy and genuinely meet people where they are at


What does this look like in practice?








HUD Translation Services



HUD's One Voice Initiative

In response to the Administration's March Executive Order that made English the official language of the United States, HUD has stated it will no longer provide translation services to those who receive its services outside of accommodations required under the Americans with Disabilities Act and Violence Againce Act, with have nondiscrimination provisions that may apply to language in some situations. Outside of those potential exceptions, HUD will switch to English-only communication for its services. Under previous administrations, HUD sought to accommodate other languages to help those with Limited English Proficiency.

Governing Council Nominations







